

Enmax is currently seeking approval for the Central Calgary Transmission Line Replacement Project, which will utilize free-standing towers as tall or taller than Mountview Apartments.

(Mountview Apartment building is 7 storeys)

Proposed Above Ground Route:

- Along the alley on the south side of Munro Park.
- South side of 17th Avenue, behind the COOP development.
- Crossing 6th Street, continuing along 17th Avenue behind Mountview Apartments, Fanning Centre, and Ambassador Motel.
- Crossing Moncton Road, jogging south and then east to parallel 16th Avenue.

Community Impact:

- Loss of value for adjacent properties up to 44.9%¹
- Aesthetic reasons/visual impact
- Sterilization of a green belt
- Impact on the quality of future development
- Noise impact hum and crackling (winter)
